

Camping Rules for relaxed coexistence

Our campsite maintains a casual and social atmosphere, but mutual consideration and respect is very important. Here are a few important behavioral rules:

1. Avoid noise

During the late evening hours until the next morning, you should keep the volume to a minimum. Evening celebrations, loud music or lively conversations late at night may disturb your neighbors.

2. Respect boundaries

Do not enter your camping neighbors' plots unasked, even not as a shortcut.

3. Collect rubbish

Ensure that your space is tidy and dispose of garbage properly. Leftover food can attract bees, wasps, various pests or even larger wildlife. Your neighbors are also likely to be disturbed by this smell. During your stay and upon departure, ensure to dispose your rubbish at the right disposal points and leave your pitch tidy. By sorting your rubbish correctly, you are also making your holiday more sustainable.

4. Properly empty the gray water tank and onboard toilet

Waste water and the contents of the chemical toilet should of course not simply be discharged into nature or the public sewerage system. Use the provided disposal stations for emptying and try to leave them as clean as possible.

5. Use the right water hose

Supply and disposal stations have a connection for fresh water as well as a connection for flushing the waste water tanks and the chemical toilet. For obvious reasons, you should make sure not to mix up these hoses. At the comfort sites, you will find a note on a water connection that this water is not suitable for drinking. At this connection, the hose for flushing the waste water tank should be connected. Please take the fresh water from the other tap.





6. Leave sanitary facilities clean

Whether it's bathrooms, toilets or washing machines, try to leave all sanitary facilities as clean as possible. If everyone contributes, the shared facilities remain more hygienic overall. We ask that you use the provided squeegees after every shower.

7. Barbecuing and open fire...

...is generally allowed. However, we always ask you to consider the weather and current risk of forest fires. You should also ensure that the smoke does not drift towards your camping neighbors, for example in strong wind. An electric grill could therefore be a good alternative.

8. If you are traveling with your dog...

... it should always be on a leash at the campsite, so that it cannot, for example, run onto the neighbors' plots or run around among the children on the playground. We ask for understanding that taking the dog into our restaurant is only limited after prior registration and it is NOT allowed on the lawn in the swimming pool area/swimming pond. We also ask you to use the dog stations and to always pick up and properly dispose of the dog's droppings, and also to collect the fur after brushing.

9. Understanding and consideration

Noise can't always be avoided – playing children or an excited dog can quickly cause a bit of commotion, without any malicious intent. Probably everyone has been the cause and victim of such situations, which is why a little indulgence is helpful in many situations.
